Main Stage

22:00 – 23:00 – Ion Maiden

Ion Maiden are a fully charged tribute to Iron Maiden, formed in 2018 by experienced musicians from the UK tribute circuit. Known for an authentic, high-energy take on the Maiden catalogue, they've built a strong following on the live circuit in the UK and beyond.

20:30 – 21:30 – Guns or Roses

Formed in 2009, Guns or Roses have built a reputation as one of the top Guns N' Roses tribute bands, performing across the UK, Ireland, and Europe. They have headlined festivals in several countries and made standout appearances at major events including the Isle of Wight Festival and Donington. With an energetic, authentic show, signature costumes, and a strong long-standing lineup, they recreate the sound, look, and attitude of the original band with real impact.

19:00 – 20:00 – Dizzy Lizzy

One of the country's leading tribute acts, they are the only band to have headlined both Vibe for Philo in Dublin and Remember Phil & Gary in Holland. They've also played major venues across Britain, including the Cavern in Liverpool, O2 Academies, and Butlin's. The band has even toured with original Thin Lizzy guitarist Eric Bell, who praised their striking resemblance in sound and stage presence.

17:30 – 18:30 – Black Country Sabbath

Black Country Sabbath are a hard-hitting tribute to Black Sabbath and Ozzy Osbourne, delivering heavy riffs, dark grooves, and classic metal power with a distinctly Black Country edge. This five-piece band brings a modern twist to the sound and spirit of one of Britain's most iconic rock legacies.

A familiar local radio voice, Paul Shuttleworth will be DJing throughout the day and in between bands next to the Main Stage. Bring your shoutouts, birthdays, and song requests and keep the weekend rolling.
